*Session Description:* Describe your session in 75 words as you want it described in the conference brochure. Participants should be able to extract the session focus, intended audience, and outcomes from your description.

*Session Plan:* Provide a brief overview of your proposal to include the outline of the session, delivery method, plan for audience participation, activities, and handouts.

*AV Requirements:* List all AV requirements. You must bring your own laptops.
